

Installation instructions for **#58625**

Replacement Lower Steering Column Bearing Kit

FITMENT NOTES: 1969-1982 Corvette & 1976-2002 GM F-BODY. This kit's components replace GM part numbers 7805822 (adapter), #7805700 (bearing), #7804440 (retainer) and #7804439 (clip).

Directions: Between 1969 and 1995 (thru 2002 on F-Body) GM used two different styles of bearings. Many cars had a metal bearing, and some cars had two rubber seals attached to the plastic adapter. This kit is designed for use with either design. This kit is installed on the bottom of the main steering column.

When installing, make sure the thicker part of the adapter fits into the slot on the metal retainer. The adapter can only seat properly in this direction. Once the thicker part of the plastic adapter is placed into the slot on the metal retainer, the bearing will lock into the retainer.

Note: The bearing comes pre-pressed into the plastic adapter. Lastly, apply a small amount of grease to the lower part of the steering shaft where the new bearing kit is going to be installed. This will make the installing process much easier.
